



Release Notes for 6.1.1 - June 1020

Language Translation

New language translation tools make it easier for an administrator to translate text in end-user applications. An administrator can translate both event-specific data (such as registration package names, session abstracts, etc.) and also static text in the end-user applications (such as menus, error messages, and buttons). (The Conference Admin Tool itself is only available in English and may not be translated.)

To translate event-specific information, an administrator can choose Setup > General > Language Translation. This area also lets the administrator select translation languages. To translate text in applications, choose Setup > General > Configurable Text. (For instructions, see the “General Event Administration” chapter in the *Administration Guide*.)

Static Text Editor

Along with language translation, the Admin Tool now makes it easier for English text to be edited in end user applications. A Business Analyst or trained administrator can change the text on many pages and dialogs throughout applications such as Registration, Call for Papers, Speaker Resource Center, Exhibitor Resource Center, etc.

ActiveEvents Connect

The name of the EventLink application has changed to ActiveEvents Connect. Throughout all applications, EventLink is now referred to as “ActiveEvents Connect” or simply “Connect.”
